Spring 2023 Interlock Rules

Travel Games:

- Associations will only play travel games on weekends.
 - RYA will travel to Haslet/Justin on 3 Saturdays during regular season.
 - HSA/JYSA will travel to North Richland Hills on 3 Saturdays during regular season.
 - Associations will play at their own home fields for Opening Day (March 25th) and Closing Day (May 20th)

End-of-Season Tournament:

- Tournament will be played on May 27, 2023.
- All teams in league will play in tournament at end of season.
 - Ranking will be based on regular season win percentage.
 - Tiebreakers for seeding will be based on head-to-head, run differential, then coin toss (if needed).
 - Associations will meet to discuss location of hosts for tournaments.
 - If needed, associations can agree to play two brackets (one for higher seeds and one for lower seeds) to limit number of games on players.
 - All participating associations in interlock leagues will provide equal payment for Championship / Finalist rings, regardless of winners.

Time Limits for Games:

- 10u – 1 hour and 30 minutes or 6 innings
- 12u – 1 hour and 45 minutes or 6 innings
- 14u – 1 hour and 45 minutes or 7 innings

Spring 2023 Interlock Rules – 10u / 12u / 14u

- No new inning will start in final ten minutes.

Run Limit:

- All ages – Maximum 5 runs per inning.
 - Exception: If a home run is hit over the fence, all runs count.
 - For example, if four runs have been scored in inning and bases are loaded, an over-the-fence home run will score all runs.

Mercy Rule:

- 15 runs after 3 innings
- 10 runs after 4 innings
- 8 runs after 5 innings

Max Pitch Counts in Game:

- 10u – 50 pitches maximum
- 12u – 60 pitches maximum
- 14u – 70 pitches maximum

Field Sizes:

- 10u – 44 feet pitching / 60 feet bases
- 12u – 48 feet pitching / 70 feet bases
- 14u – 60 feet pitching / 90 feet bases
 - Optional 14u playing 54/80 if needed

Coaching Considerations:

- All coaches must have current criminal background check by their respective associations.
- All coaches should act in manner consistent with their associations core values and remember to put the needs of children ahead of competition.
- Both home and away teams will assist in getting fields ready to play prior to the first game and will assist in closing the fields after the last game.
 - Hosting association is ultimately responsible for ensuring fields are unlocked in mornings and locked after final games.

Umpires Considerations:

- Two umpires will be used for all age levels in 10u, 12u, and 14u.
- All umpires must have current criminal background check by their respective associations.
- Only the head coaches for each team should address umpires.
 - Head coaches are responsible for conduct of their players, parents, and assistant coaches.
 - Umpires can suspend the game and eject coaches, players, and spectators if needed.
