This season's rules and supplemental rules are in effect with the following modifications:

8u

Players do not have to be rotated into an infield position.

Players may not sit on the bench for two innings in a row.

The batting order may be adjusted from game to game.

All Players present are to be included in the batting order.

Scores are to be reported to the division GroupMe after the completion of each game.

Games will be 100% coach pitch.

The games will be played for a full 75 minutes.

California Tie Breaker is in effect for all games besides the Championship game. If the score is still tied after two additional innings, the team that was ahead in the last complete inning where the score was not tied is declared the winner. If the game was tied in all the innings, the team with the higher seed is declared the winner.

The championship game is played until there is a winner.

Violations of USSSA Rules/Supplemental Rules/Playoff Guidelines-

Violations of the supplemental rules will go under review by the Baseball Staff. Their ruling will determine what action is required. Coaches do not need to announce a protest for the Baseball staff to implement an investigation or disciplinary action. If a coach refuses to cooperate with an investigation they will be immediately removed from coaching in any capacity for the remainder of the season.

Disciplinary action may include but are not limited to:

Verbal warning

Written warning (requiring acknowledgement)

Suspension (from all JYSA activities from time of ruling. May return to baseball activities after a one game suspension)

Termination of coaching responsibilities for the remainder of the season

Permanent termination of coaching privileges (requires approval of President, Executive Vice President and Vice President of Baseball)

Termination of JYSA membership (requires a board hearing and a majority vote)
